### About the Kentucky Chapter

The Kentucky Chapter of IAAO was chartered in 1996 and currently has approximately 382 members. The Kentucky Chapter has already been honored as the Outstanding Chapter at the 2000 IAAO Conference in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada and again at the 2002 IAAO Conference in Los Angeles, California.

Kentucky Chapter members bring years of combined experience in all areas of property valuation and assessment.

The Chapter is governed by the Executive Committee, which includes the Executive Director, the Chapter Officers (President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer), the state IAAO Representatives, the Immediate Past President of the Chapter, and four additional members voted on by the Chapter (One PVA, One PVA Deputy, One Revenue Employee and One At Large).

### The Benefits of Membership

For only \$20.00 a year, members receive numerous benefits, including the following:

### Education

Membership in the Kentucky Chapter qualifies students for registration at a reduced cost for IAAO courses sponsored by the Chapter.

As part of the joint effort with the Kentucky PVA Association, the Chapter awards scholarships to members every year. The program was established in 1998 to provide financial assistance for qualified students toward the expense of taking any Kentucky Property Tax Course or IAAO Course. Over \$30,000 in scholarships have been awarded in the five years since this program was founded.

IAAO professional designations are recognized across the nation as a high achievement. The designation committee of the Chapter is available to help members who wish to achieve this goal. Currently, 21 members are working towards their designation. The committee is available for support and to guide candidates through the process. The chapter has offered required courses free of charge to assist members enrolled in the IAAO professional designation candidacy program.

### Service

The Kentucky Chapter offers many opportunities to serve the community. At least once a year the Chapter participates in a fund-raising or service oriented effort. Previous chapter projects have benefitted Kosair's Children's Hospital, Ronald McDonald House, Cardinal Hill Hospital, United Way, the Diocesan Catholic Childrens' Home and the Telephone Pioneers Christmas Wish. This year's project is again benefitting Ronald McDonald House. The Chapter raised over \$6,000 by selling cookbooks.

### Opportunities

As a member of the Kentucky Chapter, you will have the opportunity to make new friends and meet new people. The Chapter hosts receptions during the Summer, Fall, and IAAO Conferences that allow the opportunity to network, catch up with old friends, and make new ones.

All chapter members also have the opportunity to serve on one of six committees: Membership, Public Relations, Education, Designation, Nominating, and Budget.

Several members of the Kentucky Chapter represent Kentucky at the national level. Karen Bushart, Clark County PVA, Ben Brown, Logan County PVA, and Jason Chinn, Ohio County PVA, serve as IAAO State Representatives and Ron Johnson, former IAAO Kentucky Chapter president, serves as Kentucky's IAAO Professional Designation Advisor. Karen Bushart also serves as IAAO Regional Representative for the south region.

Chapter members receive a chapter pin and a membership card. The chapter also publishes a newsletter, "Frontline" twice a year.

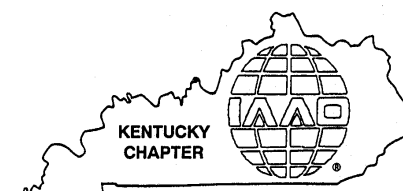
